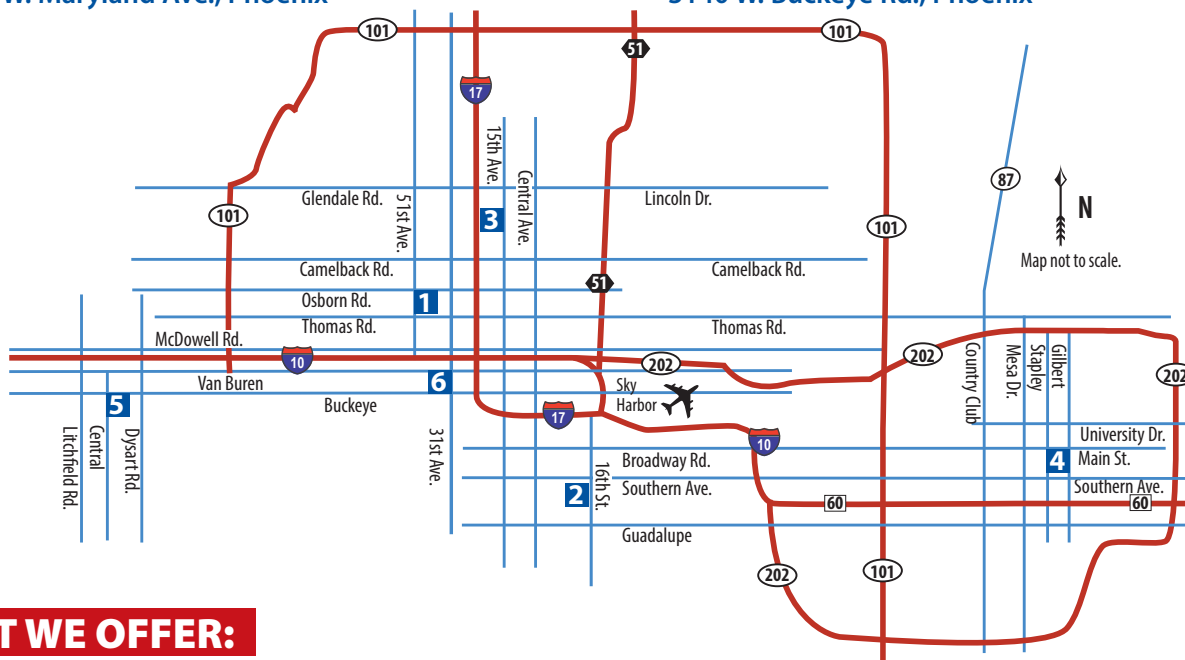
WHO WE ARE:

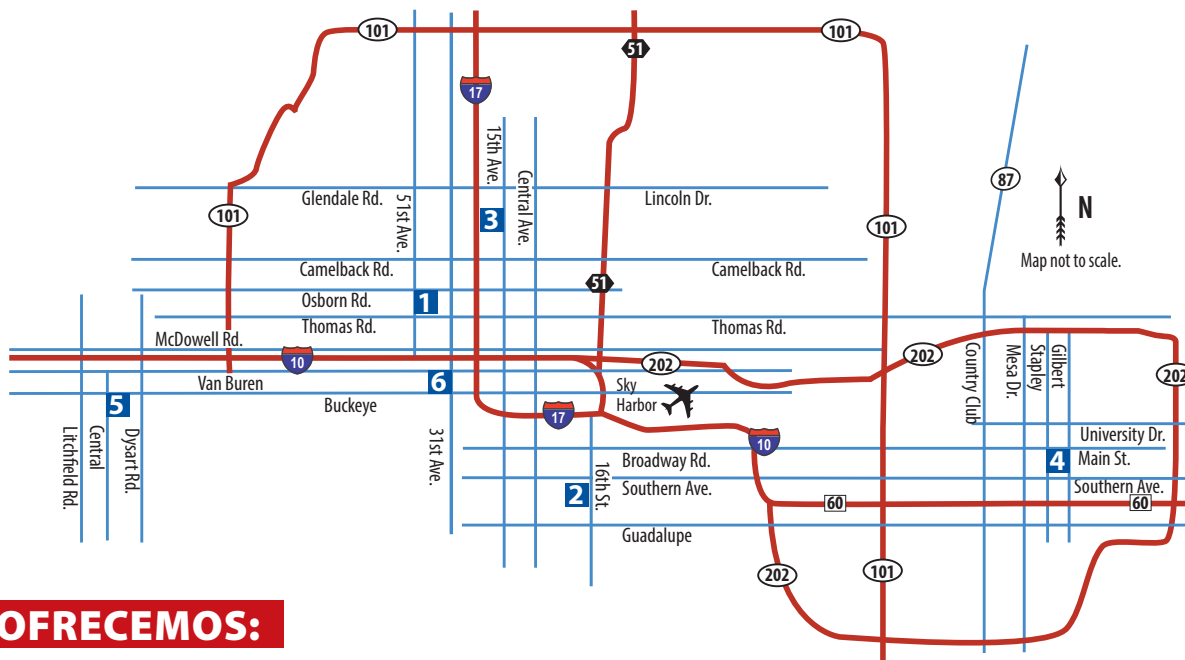
